SOME OF OUR ACTIVITIES:

This month we will create a winter scene for our display boards. We will focus our activities on size and practice using language to describe this.

The children will explore winter vegetables by chopping, roasting and then tasting them to find out which one they like.

We will look at and talk about different shapes.

Staff members will help the children to use scissors to cut out snowflakes for our display.

We will use a variety of media to decorate pictures of different types of winter clothing.

SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES FOR HOME:

Whilst cooking in the kitchen talk about the potential dangers and how to be safe in this environment.

Take part in role-play games with your child and encourage them to use their imagination widely.
